## House points can be given for:-

### Attitude to others

Kindness	By word or action.
Helpfulness	Tidying up. Opening doors. Helping others.
Cheerfulness	Keep smiling even if something doesn't go the way you planned it.
Courtesy	Listening politely saying 'please' and 'thank you' and treating others as you'd like to be treated.

### Attitude to Work

Persevering	Even when faced with problems.
Trying	Always doing your best work. Working when asked to. Best handwriting. Neat illustrations. General pride in work. Finishing work on time. Learning spellings/tables. Keeping a neat reading record. Bringing resources from home. Doing extra research.
Listening	Following a teacher's instructions.
Achieving	Academic achievement in tests/general work. Participating in an assembly/concerts etc.

**REMEMBER!** You won't always be given House Points for these things and shouldn't do things just to get them. Extra House Points may also be given if a member of staff thinks you have made a special effort or improvement in any area of your work or school life.

**A Gold Star of Excellence** (10 HPs) may be awarded to you for an outstanding piece of work.

**A Silver Star for Improvement** (5 HPs) may be awarded to you for a piece of work which shows that you have made an outstanding improvement.

**A Sapphire Star for Consistent Good Work** (5 HPs) may be awarded to you when you have demonstrated a consistently good attitude to lessons and have produced your best work.

## Warnings will be given for:-

Running	In / around school.
Forgetfulness	Missing lunch / homework
Carelessness	With belongings (yours and other people's)
Silliness	In toilets Throwing things in class. Making inappropriate comments / noises.
Rudeness	Disrupting any class. Interrupting a teacher or pupil. Unnecessarily talking after being told not to.
Dangerous acts.	Swinging on chair. Misusing PE equipment. Jumping down stairs. Rough playground games.

You may also be given an appropriate punishment, e.g. being made to return and walk down the corridor, finishing work at break etc. If you are given repeated warnings for the same thing, then you will definitely be given a single demerit.

### **DEMERITS WILL ALWAYS BE GIVEN FOR:-**

Severe rudeness	By word or action to anyone, e.g. spitting, swearing, insolence.
Dishonesty	Lying. Taking/misusing property that isn't yours.
Deliberate	Spoiling/defacing work/displays/furniture etc.
Dangerous acts	Causing hurt accidentally or intentionally by fighting / kicking / rough actions.
Poor organisation	Not bringing appropriate kit.

You might get more than one demerit at a time, e.g. take something, then lie about it = 2 demerits.

Demerits are given for **the most** serious incidents so they will be noted in your homework book or contact diary. Anyone with 2 or more demerits in a week will be in detention for 1 hour after school on the following Thursday or Friday which will have priority over all other activities on that night.

*Demerits must be reported to House Mistress/Master at the next break or at latest by the end of the day.*
