The text on the following page will be explained to children in a dedicated E-Safety lesson, after which children will be asked to sign the declaration to comply with the rules explained to them as an agreement between themselves and the school as part of the Pupil Behaviour Policy

This policy will be included in an email sent to parents to make them aware of the policy and its requirements at the start of every academic year.

This Acceptable Use Policy is intended to ensure:

- Pupils will be responsible users and stay safe while using the internet and other communications technologies for educational, personal and recreational use
- School systems and users are protected from accidental or deliberate misuse that could put the security of the systems and users at risk
- Parents and carers are aware of the importance of e-safety and are involved in the education and guidance of young people with regard to their on-line behaviour

The School will try to ensure that pupils will have good access to digital technologies to enhance their learning and will, in return, expect the pupils to agree to be responsible users.

This text is attached to the permission form, so that parents / carers will be aware of the school expectations of the young people in their care.
